

1st Amendment to The Constitution of The Empire of Arvesia

Article 1:

The definition of sentient shall include those, whose specie are proven to be able to perform the above-mentioned definitions. It is not a strict requirement of the individual.

Article 2:

Every human being has the right to access to information that are considered as having great value to our species. No entity may block access to this information or charge a fee for this information.

- 1) This information shall include, but are not limited to scientific articles, creative work of great importance, ethical debates.
- 2) A fee may be charged for use of these information in any commercial environment for 20 years after publication of these information.

Article 3:

Every citizen of The Empire of Arvesia has a right to access all information created or received by the government of The Empire of Arvesia.

- 1) Information shall be requested by an informal written document stating exactly, which information is requested.
- 2) The Government has to respond to these requests within 90 days.
- 3) Information may be withheld for an additional 90 days if their release may threaten national security of the Empire.

Article 4:

The Emperor has the capability to create legislature by an Imperial Decree. This legislature is considered law of the Empire as long as it does not violate The Constitution of The Empire.

- 1) An Imperial Decree can be blocked by parliament if a majority of at least 2/3 vote to block or modify this decree.
